

West Park Healthcare Centre Foundation Lottery Rules and Regulations

December 2019 – March 2020

By purchasing a ticket, the purchaser acknowledges that they have read, understood and agreed to these rules and regulations and confirms that they are at least 18 years of age. Any inquiries regarding the conduct, prizing and procedures of the lottery are to be made to West Park Healthcare Centre Foundation (the "Foundation") prior to purchasing a ticket.

- A total of 1,800 tickets will be printed and available for sale for two draws. The Early Bird Draw is on February 27, 2020 and the Grand Prize Draw March 28, 2020. Tickets are numbered from 1 to 1,800. The odds of winning depend on the number of tickets sold. The price per ticket is \$25 or five (5) tickets for \$100.
- 2. Tickets can be purchased by cash, credit card, cheque or bank debit. Only tickets that have been paid for (and verified as paid for) before the applicable draw deadline will be eligible for the draw. In the event of an invalid cheque or credit card payment, the ticket issued will be considered void and the purchaser will be notified in writing.
- 3. Tickets must be purchased in Ontario and cannot be mailed outside of Ontario. Ticket purchasers must be 18 years of age or older. Tickets cannot be purchased in the name of a minor.
- 4. The winning ticket of the "Early Bird" draw will also be eligible for the "Grand Prize" 50/50 draw.
- 5. The deadline to purchase tickets for the "Early Bird" draw is 1:00 pm, Feb. 27, 2020.
- 6. The "Early Bird" draw will be conducted on Feb. 27, 2020 in the Main Building Lobby, at West Park Healthcare Centre, at approximately 2:00 pm, in the presence of all attendees.
- 7. The prize for the "Early Bird" draw is a consecutive three-night stay at the Renaissance Montreal Downtown Hotel for two guests in a room with a king bed or 2 queen beds. Prize is valued at \$1,300 including taxes. Winner must book and stay before May 30, 2020. Booking is subject to availability and must be accepted as awarded. No substitutions or upgrades are allowed. Prize is not transferable and is not convertible to cash.
- 8. The deadline to purchase tickets for the "Grand Prize" 50/50 draw is March 28, 2020 at 2:00 pm.
- 9. The "Grand Prize" 50/50 draw will be held at the Foundation's event, Tournament of Stars, (Goldring Centre, U of T, Toronto) on March 28, 2020 at approximately 3:00 pm, in the presence of all

attendees.

- 10. The "Grand Prize" is 50% of the total accumulated gross revenue from ticket sales. There is a minimum guaranteed payout of \$10,000.
- 11. The winner of each draw will be announced at the draw and if necessary, notified by phone and email.
- 12. By purchasing a ticket, winners agree to have their names and photos shared on westparklottery.ca, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, the Foundation's publications, in the newspaper and in any other media deemed appropriate by the Foundation.
- 13. Prizes will be awarded to the first name listed on the front of the ticket stub.
- 14. The Foundation assumes no responsibility for lost or late mail.
- 15. Purchaser information provided on ticket stubs may be shared with the licensing authority.
- 16. The liability of the Foundation shall be limited to the ticket purchase price. Each prize winner agrees to sign a waiver in a form acceptable to the Foundation before their prize is awarded.
- 17. Unclaimed prizes will be secured for a period of 6 months from the draw date. Reasonable efforts will be made to contact the winner, including by using the contact information provided on the ticket stub. If the winner cannot be reached after 6 months, any unclaimed prize will be included in the net proceeds of the lottery.
- 18. Stated prize values are the retail value as of the date contracts were negotiated with the prize suppliers based on information provided by suppliers (without independent verification by the Foundation).
- 19. The following people are NOT eligible to purchase tickets: Foundation employees and the Foundation Board of Directors.
